

We feel like we got our messages on burn prevention out to a lot of new parents. According to Safekids Aotearoa, every day a child is burned severely enough to be admitted into hospital. Of 1 to 2 year olds admitted to hospital due to severe burns, over half are caused by spilt hot drinks and other liquids.
